### **AWARDS**

- 1st – 4th placement ribbons and qualifying ribbons are awarded in each class for each jump height (dogs optionally jumping 24" will be grouped for placement with the 20+ class).
- ATCH - ATCH rosette and ATCH bar.
- Placements for Junior Handler division classes may be combined by jump height (16"/16"+/20", 20"+/24) within each level.
- High in Trial Rosettes and awards will be calculated using the formula outlined in Section 2.6.4.2 of the ASCA Agility rulebook.
- Awards/ribbons must be picked up the day of the trial.

### **OBSTACLES**

Agility obstacles will include: Slatted A-frame & dogwalk and slatless teeter. Jumps, including double, tunnels, chute, 24" spacing weave poles and non-displaceable tire may be used at the judge's discretion.

### **ENTRY FEES**

The trial site will be available for set-up 7 a.m. Saturday.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

Entries will be accepted on a first received basis. Once the trial fills a waiting list of entries will be kept and you will be notified of your place on the list. The entry will not be considered acceptable until all information has been completed and the entry form has been submitted with the proper entry fees.

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

Checks that are presented with insufficient funds will be charged a \$25.00 fee and does not constitute a valid entry. Exhibitor will be notified and given opportunity to remedy before entry is returned. Checks will be deposited weekly as they are received.

Only dogs measuring 18” or under at the shoulder need to be measured or submit a height card with their entry. We will accept height cards from AKC or NADAC.

All dogs must be on leash when not competing.

Bitches in heat are not allowed to compete.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler not in good standing with ASCA.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### What is ASCA agility?

Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) agility is open to all dogs at least eighteen (18) months old. Courses are typically fast and flowing.

### Can any dog enter?

ASCA agility is open to all dogs. ASCA will track qualifying legs and issue title certificates for dogs with ASCA registration numbers (Aussies only) or ASCA tracking numbers, but neither is required to enter a trial. An application for an ASCA tracking number is included with this premium.

### Do I have to start in Novice?

No, you may enter at a higher level, however any qualifying scores will be used to satisfy the lower title requirements. For example, if you do not have any ASCA agility titles and you enter Open Regular, the first 30 points earned in Open will be used to satisfy the Novice requirement before being applied to the Open title.

### Do you have rubber contacts?

No, at this trial the A-frame and dog walk will have slatted surfaces. A traditional teeter will be used.

### Is training allowed in the ring?

Yes, reasonable training in the ring is allowed, but will be cause for Elimination. Collars, leashes, toys and food are not allowed in the ring.

### Is the ASCA Gamblers class a traditional gamble?

Yes. There is a 30 second opening followed by a timed gamble.

### What is required to earn a title?

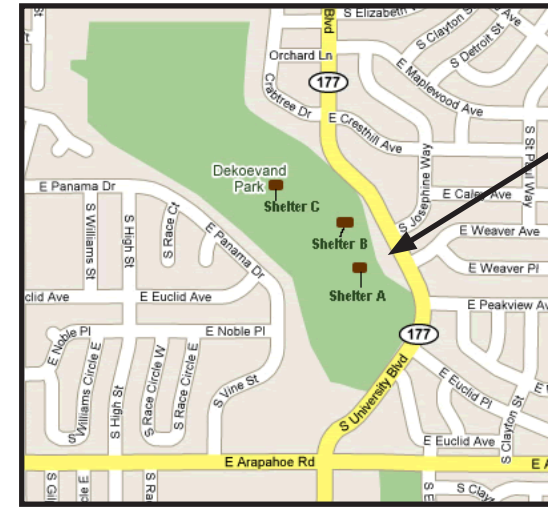
In the regular class, 30 points completes a title. A clean run earns 10 points; a faulted run (over time/dropped bar) earns 5 points. In Gamblers and Jumpers, 20 points (2 qualifying runs) completes a title. After completing a title, you may move up to the next level or work towards an Outstanding or Superior Title at the same level.

### What if I don't have an ASCA jump height card?

Send a copy of your jump height card from AKC, or NADAC in with your entry so you don't have to wait to be measured.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

Take I-25 to Arapahoe Rd. exit. West on Arapahoe Rd to University Blvd. Turn right (north) The park will be on your left. **We are in Shelter A.**

- As used here, "ASCA®" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America®, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees, and agents.
- Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to: the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures (or lack thereof), electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people. Exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- Exhibitor/owner releases ASCA®, the ASCA® affiliate club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and site owner(s) harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event, or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from, any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event; howsoever such injury, or death, may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused, or may have been alleged to have been caused, by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

# ASCA® Service Membership and Tracking Number Application

## ➤FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS◀

**Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA® registered dogs** – In order to have ASCA® qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA® titling certificates, each non-ASCA® registered dog will be required to have an ASCA® Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA® member (minimum membership type of “Service” is required). ASCA® membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. **It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA® the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA® qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.**

### Do I have to have a tracking number to compete?

No, you do not need a tracking number in order to compete in Agility or Stock.

You will need a tracking number to enter an Obedience trial or Tracking Test.

Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a tracking number from ASCA.

### Why would I need or want a tracking number for my dog?

If you would like to have your dog’s points and titles recorded by ASCA®, and if you’d like to receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you might want to obtain a tracking number.

### How much is the total cost for a tracking number?

In order to obtain a tracking number for your dog, you must be at least a “Service” member. The cost for Service Membership is **\$10**.

Your membership is good for one year; however, it does not need to be maintained in subsequent years, unless you want to obtain another tracking number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is **in addition** to the tracking fee of **\$10** per dog. A tracking number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be **\$20**. For two dogs, the cost would be **\$30**, for three, the cost would be **\$40**, etc.
